

## EOSINOPHILIC GASTRITIS AND/OR EOSINOPHILIC DUODENITIS (EG/EOD)

Eosinophilic gastritis (EG) and/or eosinophilic duodenitis (EoD), sometimes referred to as eosinophilic gastroenteritis or EGE, are chronic, inflammatory diseases characterized by high levels of mast cells and eosinophils (two types of immune system cells) in the stomach (gastritis) and/or the upper part of the small intestines known as the duodenum (duodenitis). This study will test whether AK002 can reduce eosinophils in the blood and the tissue of the stomach and/or duodenum and help improve symptoms. **If you have been diagnosed with, or think you may have EG and/or EoD, you may be eligible for this study.**

### If you experience persistent gastrointestinal symptoms like:

- Abdominal pain
- Nausea/Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Early fullness when eating
- Cramping
- Bloating
- Loss of appetite



### You may have Eosinophilic Gastritis and/or Eosinophilic Duodenitis (EG and/or EoD)

#### WHO IS ELIGIBLE

Females and males, age 18 to 80 years old who have a confirmed diagnosis of EG and/or EoD **AND/OR** have ongoing gastrointestinal symptoms
